The topic this year, announced at the venue, was **"A Disciplined Mind Is a Free Mind."**

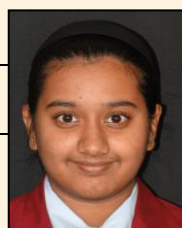
