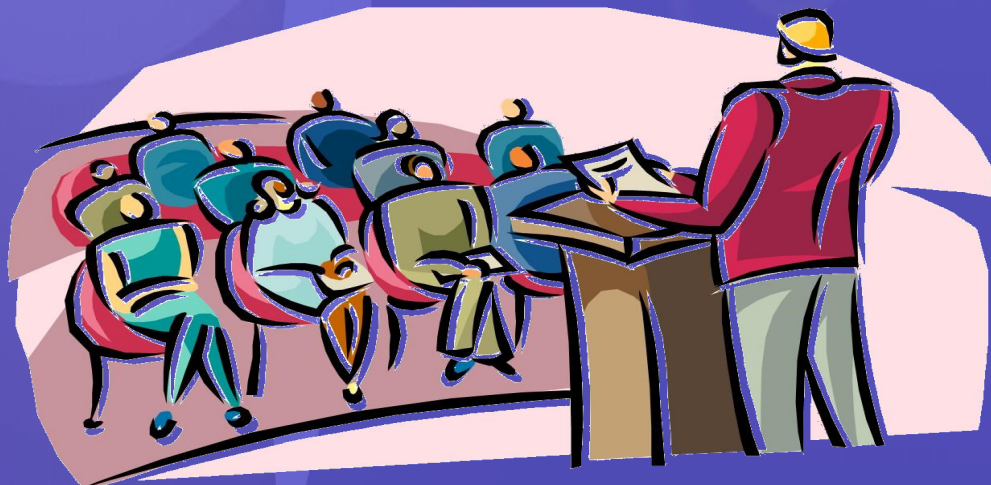

"The youth of today have put aside spiritualism in favour of materialism".

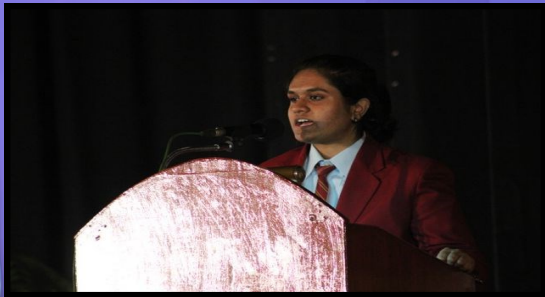
