First Position: **COOPER** AND **LUNN HOUSE** TIED FOR THIS.

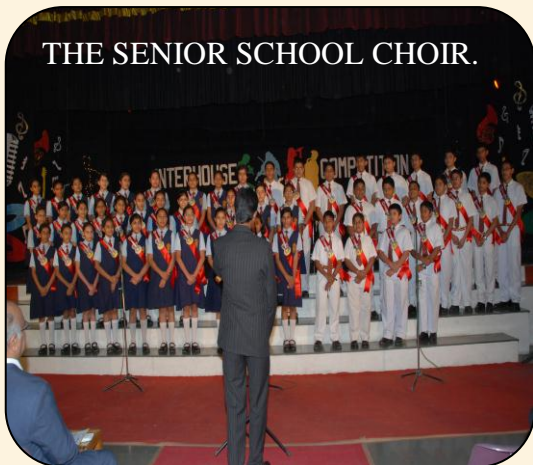
Third Position : **FREESE** HOUSE,
