A BRIEF REPORT

On Saturday, the 24th Sep. 2011, the students of class X A went on a field trip to Suzlon wind farm in Satara. It was long drive of nearly four hours through the ghats and all the winding roads which finally brought us to the wind farm. There were more than 500 wind mills spread on all the mountain tops of the Sahyadri ranges, generating 350kW to 1200 kW of electrical energy. All this and much more was explained by the engineers working there. The students saw the videos explaining the assembling and setting up of the wind mills. After lunch, the students moved around the location for some time and at 3:30pm they were back in their bus to get back to school. This trip helped the students to realise the importance of an alternative source of energy and learn to use the current resources judiciously.
