A BRIEF REPORT

The Bishop's School, Undri celebrated National Science day on 28th February 2014. At the morning assembly, Hayden Mascarenhas of VII B spoke about the significance of Science Day emphasizing the achievements of Sir. C. V. Raman.

As a part of the celebrations, the Biology laboratory was set up with some interesting demonstrations and exhibits by Class VI, VII and VIII students.

The students of class VI had displayed Medicinal, Ornamental and herbal plants used in kitchens (spices). The students of class VII demonstrated the uses of chemistry in the kitchen and in cleaning. Some of the amazing experiments were Dracula soap, Invisible ink, Corn starch Non-Newtonian motion etc. The students of class VIII demonstrated some experiments in Physics such as Hydraulic lifts, Hydraulic Robo arms, Burglar alarms, conversion of solar energy to electricity, Windmill etc. Students of various classes enjoyed viewing the displays and the demonstrations as they moved from one section to the other. They were mesmerized by experiments shown by their own friends and wondered how science can be made simple and fun to learn.

Dr. Sambuddha Ghosh was invited to give the students of class VIII a very informative lecture on the topic of Microbes. Dr. Ghosh encouraged the students to take the science group for their future studies and become scientists to solve different problems facing the Nation. An educational trip to IUCAA was also conducted for class IX students as a part of the celebrations.
