The short trip to the Lillian Deaf and Dumb School run by philanthropists Mr. & Mrs. Meshramkar was an eye opener for them. This eco-friendly school with its windmill and solar panels for the generation of energy, waste-water harvesting, bio-gas plants and provision of hot water through usage of smoke fascinated the children. The school, a Co-Education institution had a strength of 120 students. The Bishopites interacted with their new friends in sign language. They were given a demonstration of how these special children of God were taught. Later their new colleagues gave them a tour of their neat

and clean dormitories, the dining hall and the kitchen as well as a glimpse of the small farm they work on after school. The fact that these warm hearted, beautiful people excel in field of computers, and other vocations left a deep impression on the young minds of the students. The latter returned not only with feelings of appreciation and love for their fellow beings but also gratitude for what they have - the gift of hearing and speech.
