The Teacher training Workshop on PROJECT XCHANGE, was conducted by the Dell International Services India, on the 23rd of December 2011, at their office premises in the Panchshil ----. Young people offer a powerful and unique perspective on climate change. Their engagement with the issue is, however, long overdue. The Climate EduXchange programme intends to reach out to students, teachers, and the community in general to spread awareness about this key issue. Climate EduXchange aims to harness the power of ICT (information communication technology), providing a platform for students from identified parts of the country, to share information and ideas across disciplines, about how climate change is affecting them, and how India can secure a path towards sustainable development.

It was attended by two staff members. A variety of topics were covered related to modern computing and internet terminology. There was a question answer session too highlighting the uses and benefits of video conferencing, trolling, file sharing and transferring via FTP, different OS like Android, Windows and Linux.
