A BRIEF REPORT :

THE TATA BUILDING INDIA SERVICES, organized an all India English essay writing competition, in our school, on the 3rd of November, 2011.

This was held for the following 2 categories.

Category 1: Classes 6 – 8

Category 2: Classes 9 and 10.

A total of 84 students participated in this event. They were all first shown a documentary film, compiled by the Tata building India Company, as a part of their '**SPEAK FOR THE EARTH CAMPAIGN**'. This was not only highly informative in nature but also very inspiring, as all the research and presentations shown, were actually done by school children of class 8, from a reputed school in Mumbai. They showed the students how the Tata group has helped revive the number of whale sharks which migrates from the Australian waters to Gujarat to breed by prohibiting whale hunting in this area. Another milestone achievement was how they ebbed down the deterioration of the industrial area in and around Pimpri through afforestation programs.

After this 30 minute documentary, the children were seated in the library and were allotted 45 minutes to write out their essays on the topic '**HOW CAN WE MAKE OUR CITY/ HOME ENVIRONMENT, CLEANER AND GREENER**'.

The 5 best essays have been selected from each class and a total of 25 essays have been sent to the Tata building services evaluation committee for further gradation. The results of the same are awaited.
